Helen Condon is a master artist of braided rag rugs, an early American craft which uses recycled wool to create sturdy and decorative oval and round rugs, chair mats, and stair treads. Born in Newfoundland, she has her own business, Adirondack Rug Braiding, and is a frequent workshop leader at the Farmers' Museum in Cooperstown, and the Sagamore Institute at Racquette Lake. She has lead several workshops at the Schoharie River Center in the past, and she is returning to lead this two day workshop, where she will be teaching the techniques of braiding and shaping rag rugs. Participants will complete a "Hunter's Basket" during this workshop. All materials will be provided.
