The concert will take place at 3:00 p.m. at the River Center, the former Burtonville Methodist Church on Burtonville Road. Admission is by suggested donation of \$5.00 for adults. Students are free.

Dyer Switch plays hard-driving traditional music, as well as original and unique bluegrass and acoustic music. Inducted into the New York State Country Music Hall of Fame, this versatile and engaging band with dynamic stage presence has captivated audiences throughout the Northeast, Midwest and South at festivals, clubs, coffeehouses, fairs and live radio shows. The band brings together hard-driving renditions of traditional tunes from first-generation bluegrass giants like Bill Monroe and Ralph Stanley, their own powerful originals, and fresh and innovative versions of songs from other genres. The ensemble features tunes on mandolin, banjo, fiddle, guitar, dobro, bass and vocals.
